Accident Insurance

Thaksin University provides Group Accident Insurance as a welfare benefit for all students.

Coverage Details

Covers students of all academic years

24-hour accident coverage

Medical expenses covered in case of accidents

Maximum coverage: 45,000 THB per incident

Coverage period: June 1 (00:01 a.m.) – May 31 (00:00 a.m.) of the following year

The insurance covers all types of accidents, from minor injuries to death.

The insurance company will cover medical expenses and related costs. In severe cases such as permanent disability, loss of organs, or death, compensation will be paid to the insured person or the beneficiary stated in the policy.

Covered accidents include general incidents such as falls, cuts, road accidents, etc., as well as unexpected events such as assault.

Service Access

Students may receive treatment at public hospitals and private hospitals and clinics nationwide and worldwide. Students must advance payment first and then submit documents for reimbursement.

Required Documents

- 1) Claim form (available at the university clinic)
- 2) Original receipt
- 3) Original medical certificate
- 4) Police report copy (if applicable)
- 5) For compensation under Universal Health Coverage or compulsory motor insurance, the medical certificate must specify date and time of treatment

Dental Treatment

Tooth extraction and wisdom tooth surgery must be used in public hospitals only nationwide with maximum reimbursement: 1,000 THB per year. Students must advance payment first.

Coverage Limit

Medical expenses up to 10,000 THB per academic year

Not Covered

- 1) Special service fees outside government hours / Gold Card fee
- 2) New medical card fee / non-listed medicines / medical certificate fee / private room charges (covered at standard ward rate only)
- 3) Cosmetic surgery / acne treatment / prosthetics / glasses / contact lenses
- 4) Dialysis
- 5) AIDS and sexually transmitted diseases

Service Locations

- 1) Public hospitals nationwide only
- 2) Private clinics and hospitals are not eligible for reimbursement

Required Documents for Reimbursement

- 1) Claim form (available at the university clinic)
- 2) Original receipt
- 3) Original medical certificate
- 4) Certified copy of bank account
- 5) Certified copy of ID card or student ID

Medical reimbursement follows official government regulations.

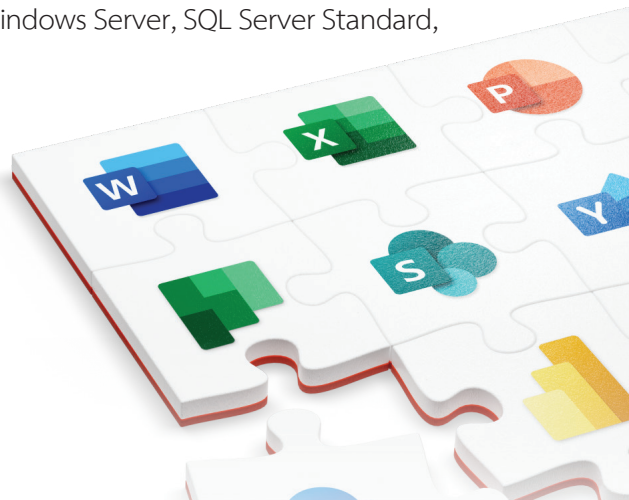

PLANNING TRIP

In coming to Thailand as an international student, you are supposed to bring essential documents required for your trip and immigration control checking at the airport or border immigration checkpoint. In addition, you are required to prepare your educational documents for enrollment at Thaksin University.

The following is the list of essential documents you must bring to Thailand:

- 1) Your valid passport (the expired date must remain more than 6 months before leaving the Kingdom of Thailand in case an unexpected situation occurs)
- 2) Your visa and/or other entry clearance documents (if any)
- 3) Traveling and insurance documents
- 4) Health certificates or medical checkup certificates
- 5) Letter of Acceptance from Thaksin University
- 6) Financial Certificates; a bank statement, a sponsor's letter and/or scholarship approval
- 7) Your educational documents for enrollment: examination certificates, language certificate, academic transcript.
- 8) Sparing passport-sized photographs
- 9) International driver license (if any)
- 10) Photocopies of all essential documents.

Essential Stuff

- 1) Medication is prioritized.
- 2) Making photocopies of all-important documents will be useful in case of loss and emergency
- 3) Universal plug, 3-round pin, 2-flat pin power outlets/plugs/sockets with no earth is regularly used for 220V electric supply.

VISA

Visa Application

It is for your own benefit to apply for a Non-Immigrant ED visa prior to your departure from your country for Thailand. Required documents for applying for a Non-Immigrant ED

- 1) An application form, which is filled out and signed by the applicant
- 2) Original current passport and previous passport(s) (if any)
- 3) A passport photo (4x6 cm) of the applicant (Some embassies/consulates may request more than one photo.)
- 4) Academic certificate(s) at an upper-secondary/ high school or university level (as appropriate)
- 5) A cover letter signed by the authority of your host Faculty/Institute/School, together with a photocopy of his/her ID card/passport, endorsed with his/her signature; or an invitation letter issued by the host institution.
- 6) A certificate of admission signed by the authority of your host Faculty/ Institute/School, together with a photocopy of his/her ID card/passport, endorsed with his/her signature
- 7) Financial evidence (e.g. a bank statement, proof of sponsorship)

Remark: Dress Code Guidelines for Visitors to the Immigration Bureau

Please wear appropriate clothes or a student uniform.

Visa Extension

Once the Immigration Bureau approves your entrance into Thailand, your passport will be stamped with the conditions of entry, and the Immigration Bureau will issue the duration of your stay in the Kingdom of Thailand. The last date issued by the officer at the checkpoint may not cover your study period at Thaksin University, therefore, you must apply for visa extension at the Thai Immigration Bureau before the last date engraved on the immigration stamp. Those wishing to extend their stay must apply for visa extension, and they may be permitted to stay in the country up to a maximum of one year. They may continue to apply for a renewal of their stay on a yearly basis, until the end of their work or study period. Ask your host Faculty/Institute/School to issue a letter in support of your application for visa extension and submit it to International Relations Office, Room 18203, The President's Office Building, Building 18.

Important Notes:

- Application is only accepted within the period of 45 days prior to the expiry date of the current visa (with some exception upon consultation with the Immigration officer).
- A fine of 500 THB per day will be applied to those who overstay in the Kingdom of Thailand with certain penalties. However, the amount fined will not exceed 20,000 THB.

Non-Immigrant ED Visa documents to be submitted to the Immigration Bureau:

- 1) An application form (TM 7) which is filled out and signed by the applicant
- 2) A passport photo (4x6 cm) of the applicant (The Immigration Bureau may request for more than one photo.)
- 3) Fee (1,900 THB)
- 4) A photocopy of the first page of the applicant's passport

- 5) A photocopy of the page showing visa expiry date (Visa stamping page)
- 6) Departure card (TM.6)
- 7) A letter issued by your host Faculty/Institute/School in support of the visa extension application (in Thai) *valid for 45 days after the signed date*
- 8) An academic transcript
- 9) The accommodation contract
- 10) A report letter issued by your host Faculty/Institute/School on the total class and lab hours in the past academic year (for students applying for visa extension for the second year onwards)

Re-entry Permit

International students who are holding a single-entry visa and plan to travel outside Thailand for a short period during the time when the visa is valid, are needed to apply for a re-entry permit before traveling. You are recommended to contact the exchange program

coordinators at your host Faculty/Institute/School

You will need to submit the following:

- 1) Passport
- 2) Application Form T.M. 8
- 3) 2 inches photo
- 4) Re-entry permit fee
- 5) Single Re-Entry Permit: the applicant can leave and reenter only once. Price for single re-entry is THB 1,000 THB.
- 6) Multiple Re-Entry Permit: the applicant can leave and reenter the country multiple times for the duration that the visa is valid. Price for multiple re-entry is 3,800 THB.

Remark:

It is important that the students should carefully study the immigration regulations when they travel to different countries. The regulations are changed very often, the incoming students should check the most update policies on the Royal Thai Embassy website.

Change of Affiliation

Those holding a certain non-immigrant visa wishing to change their affiliation may request the change of affiliation at the Immigration Bureau in Thailand (e.g. those holding an ED visa at an academic institution in Thailand wishing to change to another institution.) Request your former host Faculty/Institute/School to issue a letter of affiliation cancellation, and ask the new institution that has accepted you to issue a letter to request for affiliation change in support of application for visa extension and submit them to Immigration Division 1, Immigration Bureau*

Important Note:

The date of cancellation of your affiliation with the former institution must fall exactly on (or at least overlap with) the date of acceptance to the new institution to avoid overstaying in the country. In the case where there is a gap between the cancellation and the acceptance date, a foreign student may risk being penalized for his/her overstay in the country and may have to leave the country and re-enter on a new visa.

Visa Termination

When you terminate your status as a student (withdrawal of student status, graduation, etc.) in Thailand, you also need to terminate your current visa to comply with the immigration law. Request your host Faculty/Institute/School to issue a letter of visa termination together with other related documents and submit them to the Immigration Bureau.

Important Notes:

Application for the termination of a visa is accepted within the period of twenty-one (21) days prior to the desired date of termination or the last day of student or employment status.

The term “last day of student status” means the date a student is granted a degree (by the University Council, and this date will normally be written on the transcript or the degree certificate.) However, please bear in mind that the day of the commencement ceremony is not the official date of graduation as many students mistake the day of the commencement ceremony as the graduation date. This results in an unintentional overstay in the country. (The date of graduation is, in general, prior to the day of the commencement ceremony).

SKILL TRANSCRIPT

Thaksin University conducts skill assessments and issues a Skill Transcript to enhance students' readiness for the job market. The Skill Transcript serves as a significant advantage in job applications, responding to the demands of the modern labor market, which increasingly values practical skills, hands-on experience, and adaptability.

The assessment covers seven essential skills for professional life:

- 1) Critical thinking and problem-solving
- 2) Self-management
- 3) Teamwork and collaboration
- 4) Digital technology literacy
- 5) Communication skills
- 6) Entrepreneurship
- 7) Social innovation

Skill Assessment Registration

How to Use the Skills Assessment System

1) Register for the Skill Assessment at <https://skill.tsu.ac.th/index.jsp>



Log in > Select Register for Examination > Choose your preferred assessment round (Log in using the same Username and Password as the Student Registration System (e-Enroll)).

2) Check Your Seat Number

Students can check their assigned seat number after the application period for each round has ended. Log in > Select Check Seat Number

3) Check Assessment Results

Students can check their results on the day following the assessment date.

Log in > Select Examination Results

Students who obtain an average score of more than 60% will be considered as having passed.

4) Print the Skill Transcript

Students who pass the assessment (average score above 60%) may print their Skill Transcript via the Student Registration System, <https://enroll.tsu.ac.th/>

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate students enrolling from Academic Year 2023 onward must meet the required English proficiency standard (English Exit Exam), pass the Digital Literacy Examination, and participate in extracurricular student development activities for graduation.

English Exit Exam

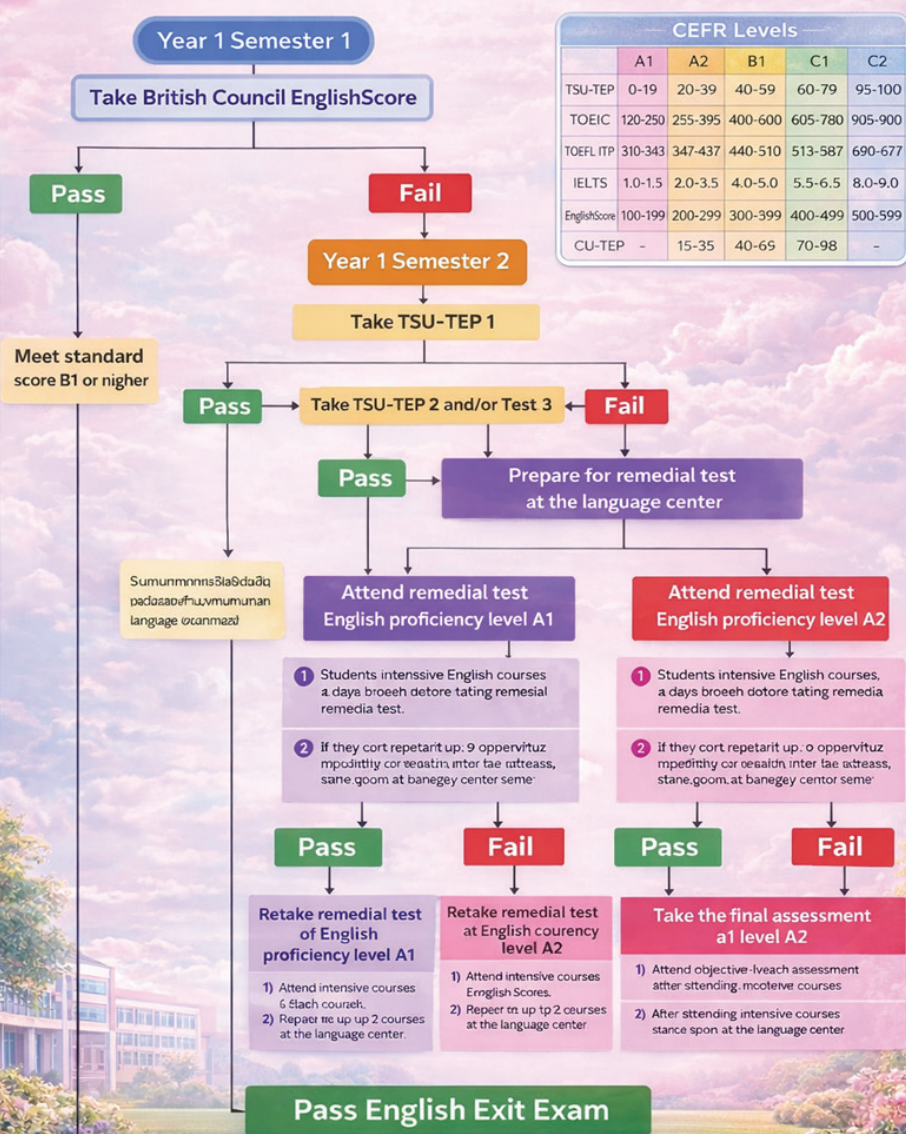
Thaksin University has established English language proficiency requirements for undergraduate students as a graduation condition, effective from Academic Year 2023 onward to set English proficiency standards for students and promote continuous English language development.

Pass English Exit Exam

Students must achieve **at least CEFR Level B1** and submit valid test results (not older than 2 years) to the Language Center before graduation. Accepted test results include TSU-TEP and other recognized English proficiency tests (subject to case-by-case approval).

Students must take the EnglishScore test, Core Skills, free of charge up to 4 times in the first academic year and/or TSU-TEP free of charge up to 3 times during their study period. Students may attend one free preparatory course for the TSU-TEP through the TSU MOOC for ALL system.

Alternative Pathways

Students who score below B1 (A1 or A2 levels) may fulfill the requirement through approved alternatives such as:

- 1) Intensive English training courses (45 hours per course)
- 2) Enrolling in specified English elective courses (3–6 credits depending on level)
- 3) Completing approved English skill development courses
- 4) Participating in English competency development activities

Minimum achievement for courses/training: at least 60% or grade C or higher, depending on the chosen option.

Certification and Transcript

Students who meet the requirement will receive an official English proficiency certificate indicating CEFR level (A1–C2).

S (Satisfactory) – Passed

U (Unsatisfactory) – Not passed

Digital Literacy Test of Thaksin University

According to the Thaksin University Regulations on Undergraduate Studies, B.E. 2566 (2023), Chapter 10: Graduation, Conferment of Degrees, and Honors, Clause 32.4 states that students eligible for graduation must possess the required qualifications. Clause 34.2.3 further stipulates that students must fulfill other qualifications as prescribed by the University.

Therefore, the Institute of Learning Resources and Digital Technology Institute, in collaboration with the Department of Computer and Information Technology,

Faculty of Science and Digital Innovation, Thaksin University, has developed a Digital Literacy Competency Examination, which includes designated test content and an online testing system.

The examination consists of 9 components, totaling 100 questions, with a testing time of 90 minutes, as follows:

- 1) Computer Usage (10 points)
- 2) Internet Usage (15 points)
- 3) Cybersecurity Awareness (5 points)
- 4) Word Processing Applications (15 points)
- 5) Spreadsheet Applications (15 points)
- 6) Presentation Software (15 points)
- 7) Digital Media Creation Tools (10 points)
- 8) Online Collaboration (10 points)
- 9) Digital Security Practices (5 points)

Testing System and Procedure

Before accessing the online examination system, students must log in using the same Username and Password as the Student Registration System.

The examination consists of 100 multiple-choice questions, with a total testing time of 90 minutes.

Assessment Criteria

Students must meet one of the following minimum requirements:

1) Achieve a score of **not less than 70 points** on the Digital Literacy Examination administered by the Learning Resources and Digital Technology Institute, Thaksin University.

2) Obtain a result of **Pass or higher** in the ICDL Workforce Basics program from the International Computer Driving License (ICDL) Institute.

3) Achieve a score of **not less than 55 points** in the Information Technology Passport Examination (IP), Level 1, under the IT Professional Examination (ITPE)

project.

4) Obtain a Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Certificate at the **CORE level or higher**.

5) Obtain a result of Pass or higher in the IC3 Digital Literacy Certification – **Global Standard 5**.

6) Obtain a result of **Pass or higher** in the CompTIA IT Fundamentals+ (CT-ITF+) certification from CompTIA.

Examination Registration Procedures

1. Registration for the First Attempt

Students must complete online registration as follows:

1) Register at: <http://dlt.tsu.ac.th>



2) Log in using the same Username and Password as the Student Registration System. The examination format is Multiple Choice (first attempt).

3) Select the examination round and campus according to your student status.

Thaksin University students taking the examination for the first time are exempt from the examination fee, except in the case of a re-examination. Students may check the list of examinees, examination room, date, and time at <http://dlt.tsu.ac.th> prior to the examination date.

2. Registration and Payment for Re-examination

Students must complete online registration as follows:

1) Register at: <http://dlt.tsu.ac.th>



2) Log in using the same Username and Password as the Student Registration System.

The examination format is Multiple Choice (re-examination).

Students are allowed to take the examination free of charge for up to two attempts. If unsuccessful after these attempts, students must register for a re-examination with a fee of 200 THB per attempt at: <https://dlt.tsu.ac.th/>

After registering for the re-examination, students must print the examination confirmation form and submit it together with the 200 THB fee.

Examination Regulations

1) Arrive at the examination room on time at the Learning Resources and Digital Technology Institute (Computer Building). Students arriving more than 15 minutes late will not be permitted to enter.

2) Wear the official student uniform.

3) Present your student ID card.

4) Bring your University Username and Password.

5) The use of all communication devices is strictly prohibited in the examination room.

6) Comply with all examination rules and regulations.

Any form of cheating will result in disciplinary action in accordance with the University's Student Discipline Regulations.

Extracurricular Activity Hours

Thaksin University requires undergraduate students to participate in extracurricular student development activities as an additional graduation requirement.

Required Hours

Regular program students: At least 60 hours throughout their study period
Continuing/Special program students (2-year programs): At least 30 hours

Students who complete the required hours will receive an Activity Transcript upon graduation.

Activity Structure

1. Mandatory Activities

Students must participate in at least 3 mandatory activities totaling **not less than 12 hours**, including:

- 1) university orientation
- 2) activities related to university life
- 3) activities promoting inspiration for social innovation and entrepreneurship

2. Elective Activity Groups

1) TSU Glocal Talent

This focuses on 21st-century skills and global citizenship, including critical thinking and problem-solving, self-management, teamwork, digital literacy, volunteerism and environmental activities (TSU Good). The students must complete **at least 22 hours** in this group (with specific minimum hours per category).

2) TSU Communication Talent

This focuses on communication skills (listening, speaking, reading, writing, and language use).

Full-time students: at least 10 hours

Part-time students: at least 4 hours

3) **TSU Social Innovation / Entrepreneurship Talent**

This focuses on social innovation and entrepreneurial development aligned with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Full-time students: at least 16 hours

Part-time students: at least 5 hours

Students may choose activities in social innovation, entrepreneurship, or both.

Hour Calculation

Minimum count: 1 hour per activity

Maximum: 8 hours per day

Travel time and breaks are not counted.

External activities must include official certification and supporting documents.

Record and Certification

Activity participation is recorded in the University's information system.

Prem Auditorium is a distinctive and innovative name in the field of music. The name was graciously authorized for use by Prem Tinsulanonda, former Prime Minister, President of the Privy Council of Thailand, and National Statesman, to serve as its leading title. It carries a unique meaning, conveying a sense of comfort, joy, and fulfillment. It reflects the idea that music is something beautiful and expresses a deep love for musical sound.

For the Prem Auditorium at Thaksin University, Prem Tinsulanonda, former President of the Privy Council of Thailand and National Statesman, envisioned the construction of a large-scale venue for musical and performing arts events. In 2011 (B.E. 2554), he initiated the concept of designing a concert hall equipped with the finest sound system in Songkhla Province.





This vision was rooted in the belief that music, melody, and the arts can refine the mind and elevate the aesthetic sensibilities of youth and people in the southern region of Thailand. Thaksin University embraced this initiative and collaborated with both public and private sector partners to bring the project to completion in 2019 (B.E. 2562).

The result is a beautiful public landmark named “Prem Auditorium”—a venue dedicated to musical and performing arts presentations under a new dimension and concept of music. Beyond serving as a place of entertainment, it also promotes the use of music as a tool for social development. “Prem Auditorium” therefore stands as a symbol of virtue and cultural refinement of the nation, and represents a new mark of civilization for the southern community.

TSU Shop & Souvenir is the official university store of Thaksin University located on the ground floor of the main building.

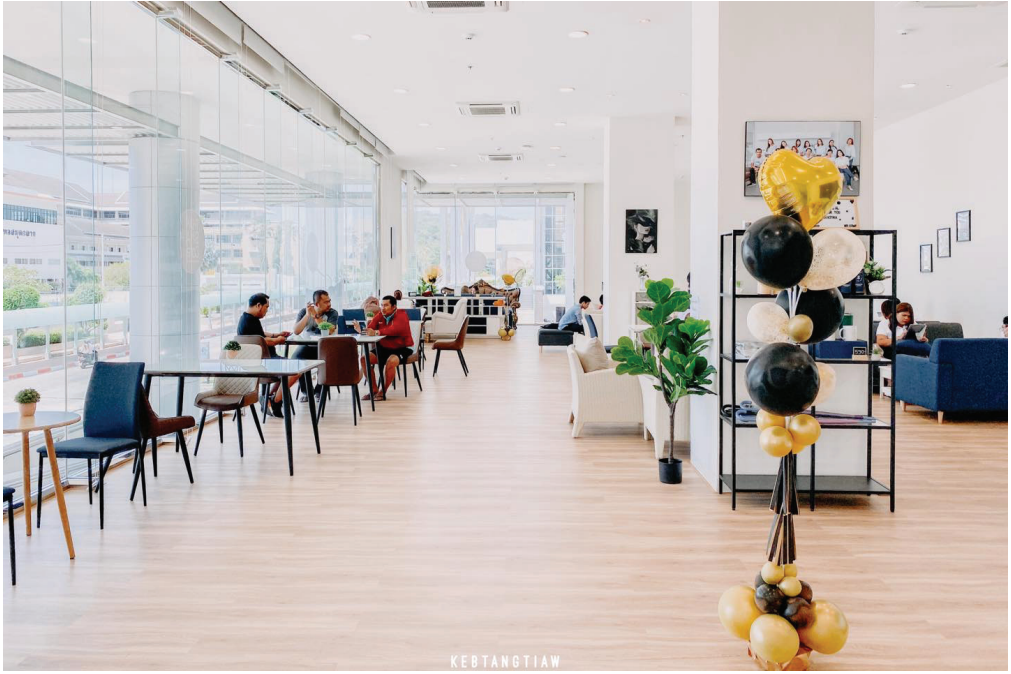


Thaksina Café
